Pfizer Acquisition

Pfizer acquires Warner-Lambert, along with all of its subsidiary companies, including Parke-Davis.

Capsugel Acquisitions

Capsugel aquires two companies: Encap Drug Delivery, a CDMO; & Bend Research, a company involved in drug delivery technologies.

Parke-Davis company begins making the first empty two-piece hard capsules at their facility in Detroit, Michigan.

Parke-Davis Merger

Parke-Davis company merges with American pharmaceutical giant Warner Lambert.

Pfizer Sells Capsugel

Pfizer sells their Capsugel subsidiary to global investment firm Kohlberg Kravis Roberts for \$2.38B.

Lonza Acquires Capsugel

Capsugel acquires Xcelience in early 2016. In December, Lonza acquires Capsugel for \$5.5B from KKR.
